



MINI HOLLAND UPDATE – Consultations

We need you to complete four Kingston Council consultations!

We understand Kingston are planning to go to consultation on four Mini-Holland / Go Developments cycle schemes in June 2016 and we're asking members and supporters to back them all.

At time of writing the proposals are not finalised:

1. Surbiton

This is the middle section of the Kingston-to-Surbiton-to-Tolworth route via Surbiton Crescent and Avenue Elmers.

Links to Surbiton station are provided by Claremont Road and St Marks Hill - which needs to be protected on both up and downhill.

2. Fountain Roundabout, New Malden

A junction or crossroads with traffic lights and shared space for cyclists replaces the roundabout.

We're asking that the shared space is wide on all sides of the junction.

3. Wheatfield Way

Two way segregated cycle track runs from College Roundabout to Kingston station save for a section shared with pedestrians near Old London Road.

We're calling for a trial of segregated space on the proposed shared section.

4. Kingston Station Plaza

A cycle hub is proposed, together with links to the river.
